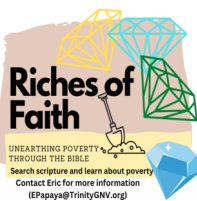


**Wednesday Night Dinners** – the best deal in Gainesville.

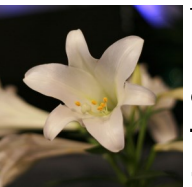
