



P: Christ has died; Christ is risen; Christ will come again.

L: Pour out your Holy Spirit on all gathered here and on these gifts of bread and cup. Make them be for us the body and blood of Christ Jesus, that we may be for the world the body of Christ, redeemed and reconciling. Through Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit, all honor and glory is yours, Holy God, now and forever.
