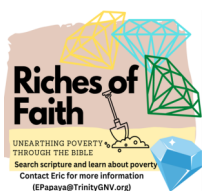
Wednesday Night Dinner, Classes & Worship

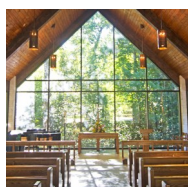


New Class Starting Soon at Trinity: Riches of Faith | Unearthing Stories of Poverty in the Bible - March 13

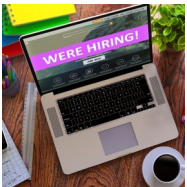

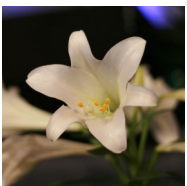
