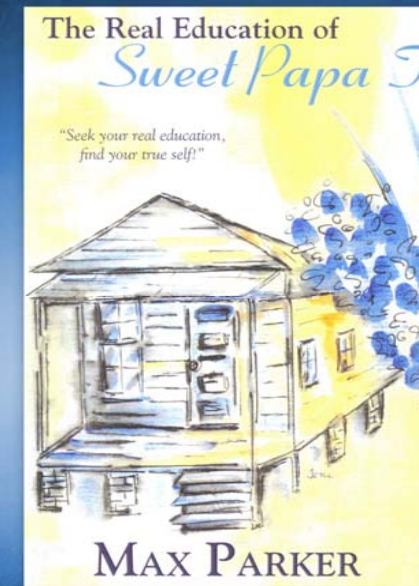
Music
