This Morning: A Special Service Of Choral Music

The combined choirs of Trinity will offer a special service of choral music under the direction of our two guest conductors, Mr. Joseph Martin and Dr. Milburn Price at both 8:15 am and 11:00 am. At 9:40 am we will have a special service of music and scripture for Mother's Day.



Mr. Joseph Martin is recognized throughout the United States for his many choral compositions, both sacred and secular, his music can be heard in such diverse locations as Carnegie Hall and Lincoln Center in New York City; Constitution Hall in Washington DC; St. Peter's Basilica in Vatican City; and in hundreds of worship services in churches across the United States and Canada. He has been the featured artist with symphony orchestras in the United States and Mexico. As winner of the Nina Plant Wideman Competition, he performed with the Guadalajara Symphony Orchestra.



Dr. Milburn Price, a past president of the American Choral Directors Association (ACDA), was recently the recipient of a lifetime achievement award in choral conducting, presented at Carnegie Hall. As a retired Dean of the School of Music at Samford University, in addition to previously serving in similar positions at both Furman University and Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, he has been a highly sought-after guest clinician for music festivals and workshops across the United States.

A grant provided through the Trinity UMC Foundation has made this special service of choral music possible.
