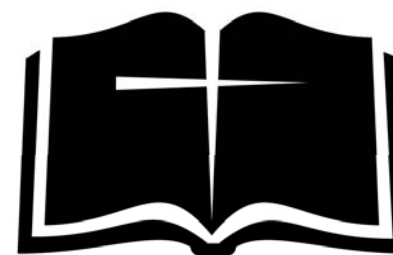

SWAG is raising money for the creation of the CHILD Center, a quality early learning center for approximately 50 low-income children age 0 to 5 in the heart of the SWAG neighborhoods. It will provide comprehensive child care and early education in a safe and healthy learning environment, and will offer other valuable resources such as nutritious meals, early identification of learning issues, creative play and daily exercise. The CHILD Center will also provide parent programming on topics such as parenting practices, safety and nutrition, and will offer safe, quality childcare to caregivers that need to go to work, school, or attend other self-improvement programs. Because of the proximity and connection to the SWAG Family Resource Center and the SW Health Clinic, families will have access to broader resources to promote self-reliance, as well as medical and dental services, and will be able to take advantage of a comprehensive system of care for the well-being of entire families. 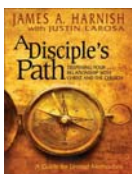
