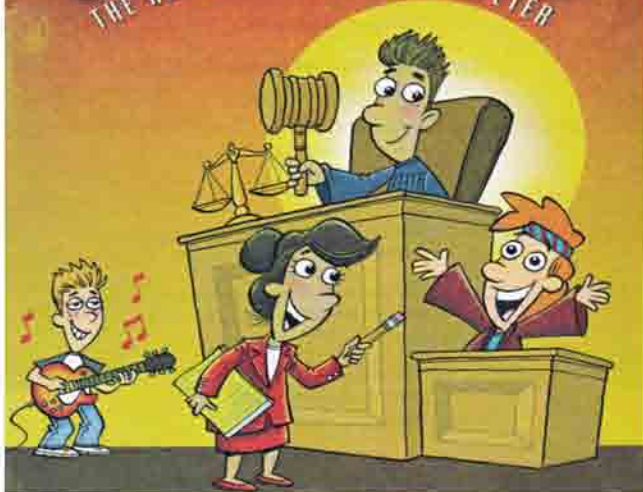


Donations can be dropped off any time from now through February 19 in the collection boxes located in the Narthex, at the front desk of the Education Building, in the Atrium, or Youth Building.
